### Dear friends and supporters:

2022 was our first year back to normal, fully in-person operations after the COVID-19 pandemic. The pandemic impacted all of us in many ways, but unquestionably, the biggest impact was felt by our youth. The Boys & Girls Clubs of Collin County continues to serve our youth in many ways, providing a caring, nurturing, and safe environment for our members to learn, grow, and have fun! By the end of 2022, we almost reached pre-pandemic levels for daily attendance and membership. Our aim is to continue to grow the impact of our mission and reach more youth every year.

Thank you to our amazing team members in our branches and our admin office for going above and beyond every single day to deliver positive impact for our members. Thank you also to all our supporters, our corporate and community partners and all our individual donors for continuing to support our mission and for making a difference in the lives of many young people across Collin County.

These are exciting times for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Collin County. We now serve our communities through 8 branch locations, including our three flagship branches in McKinney, Frisco, and Plano; along with three in-school clubs in Princeton; one in-school club in Frisco; and our newest club location in Cotton Groves in McKinney's Bumpas neighborhood in collaboration with Habitat for Humanity. In our branches, we continue to provide innovative programming to our member youth, including eSports, coding, or financial literacy.

During the summer of 2022, we welcomed more than 700 kids to our summer camps in our branches in Frisco, McKinney, and Plano. The days were filled with activities, laughs and many new friendships being built. For many summer campers, the highlights were the 90+ field trips over the course of the summer!

In October 2022, we were able to host our first in-person Gala post COVID, celebrating our mission with 800 supporters and friends at the Chrysalis Ball Enchanted Masquerade. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and supporters, we were able to raise \$1.1 million during the evening to support our club programs. Our 2023 Chrysalis Ball A Night at the Cabaret will take place on Saturday, October 14.

As Collin County continues to grow, so is the need for our mission. As we look into the future, Boys & Girls Clubs of Collin County aim to serve more of our young people in more branches across Collin County with innovative programming that prepares our youth to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens. In order to continue to meet & exceed our goals, we need corporate and individual donors, mentors, tutors, and families to join our mission.

Founded in 1968, BGCCC has a 54-year history of creating great futures in North Texas. Strategically located in low-income neighborhoods, BGCCC provides a safe, positive environment during the most vulnerable hours of a youth's day: The after-school hours. We convert these hours into time that helps youth reach their full potential. BGCCC's four clubs serve youth aged 5 - 18 in Frisco, Plano, McKinney, and outlying areas including in-school sites at Smith Elementary, Lacey Elementary, and Harper Elementary in Princeton. BGCCC also has one community-based Club in the Habitat for Humanity Cotton Groves Community.

As the largest youth-serving organization in Collin County, excluding school districts, we currently provide more than 4,800 youth with a safe place to learn and grow into productive, responsible, and caring citizens. They are offered an affordable, safe, and nurturing environment and are supported with a variety of programs and activities that assist in their educational, emotional, physical, and social development. We never turn away a young person in need. Membership fees for programming and transportation are provided on scholarship if necessary.

Thanks to the support of our generous donors, our Clubs continue to grow and reach more youth more often every year – youth who are our future.

# PROGRAMS

Our innovative programs are designed to empower youth to excel in school, become good citizens and lead healthy, productive lives. Each Club operates 15-20 programs utilizing proven and nationally recognized content in five Core Program Areas that closely align with the developmental needs of all young people:

- The Arts
- Education
- Health & Wellness
- Leadership & Service
- Sports & Recreation

When programs are executed to the best of their ability, they create a Club Experience that enables youth to achieve positive outcomes in three priority areas:

- Academic Success
- Good Character and Citizenship
- Healthy Lifestyles

Together, BGCA and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Collin County follow the Formula for Impact – our roadmap for ensuring that young people have a positive, impactful Club Experience and, ultimately, achieve the important outcomes that lead them to great futures.

*Our programs are designed to encourage Club members to realize a wide variety of positive outcomes, a strategy for developing the “whole child.”*

## ACADEMIC SUCCESS PROGRAMS

These comprehensive programs enable youth to become proficient in basic educational disciplines, apply learning to everyday situations, and embrace technology to achieve success in a career.

**Project Learn** Project Learn reinforces and enhances the skills and knowledge young people learn at school during the hours they spend at the Club. This comprehensive program strategy is based on research showing that students do much better in school when they spend their non-school hours engaged in fun, but academically beneficial, activities.

**PowerHour** helps Club members ages 6-18 achieve academic success by providing homework help, tutoring, and high-yield learning activities and encouraging members to become self-directed learners.



**Money Matters** promotes financial responsibility and independence among Club members ages 13-18 by building their basic money management skills. Participants learn how to manage a checking account, budget, save and invest.

**DIY Stem Do It Yourself (or DIY) STEaM** is an



activity-based program that brings scientific principles to life. The program uses items

commonly found in the Club, or can be easily procured, to introduce Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematical (STEaM) concepts to youth. DIY STEM is a program that can be implemented in its entirety or as separate units depending on the needs and interests of various Club kids.

**Workforce Development Initiative** capitalizes on existing job skills and career development programs to create and implement a robust local workforce development program for youth. The program will prepare teens to enter the workforce while engaging local employers as they get ready for the next generation of employees.





## GOOD CHARACTER AND CITIZENSHIP

We empower youth to support and influence their Club and community while developing relationships, setting a positive self-image and having respect for cultural differences.



**Keystone Clubs** provide leadership development opportunities for young people ages 14 to 18. Youth participate in activities in three focus areas: academic success, career preparation and community service. With the guidance of an adult advisor, Keystone Clubs aim to have a positive impact on members, the Club and community.



**Torch Clubs** are chartered, small-group character and leadership clubs for boys and girls ages 11 to 13. Torch Club members elect officers and work together to implement projects in the four focus areas: service to Club and community; education; health and fitness; and social recreation.



**Youth of the Year** is our signature effort to foster a new generation of leaders, fully prepared to live and lead in a diverse, global and integrated world economy.

## HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

Every day at the Club, we provide nutritious snacks, engaging fitness activities, and competitive sport leagues to get Club members excited about leading healthy lifestyles.



**Triple Play** is a comprehensive health and wellness program. It strives to improve the overall health of Club members ages 6-18 by increasing daily physical activity, teaching them about good nutrition and helping them develop healthy relationships.

**Passport to Manhood** teaches responsibility to boys ages 11 to 14 with sessions that focus on a specific aspect of character and manhood through highly interactive activities.



**SMART Girls** provides health, fitness, prevention/education and self-esteem enhancement for girls ages 8 to 17.

**SMART Moves** SMART (Skills Mastery and Resistance Training) Moves addresses problems such as drug and alcohol use and premature sexual activity.

### 2021 MEMBER DEMOGRAPHICS

In 2021, Boys & Girls Clubs of Collin County serve 1,272 members, giving them a safe place to learn and grow into productive and caring citizens. 49% of the members served are female; 51% are male. The majority of members in the program are African American at 59%; 19% are Caucasian; 15% are Hispanic; 2% are Asian; and 5% are of another ethnicity.

BGCCC serves youth from all levels of household income. 31% of members are eligible for free/reduced lunch and 43% of members live in a non-traditional household.
